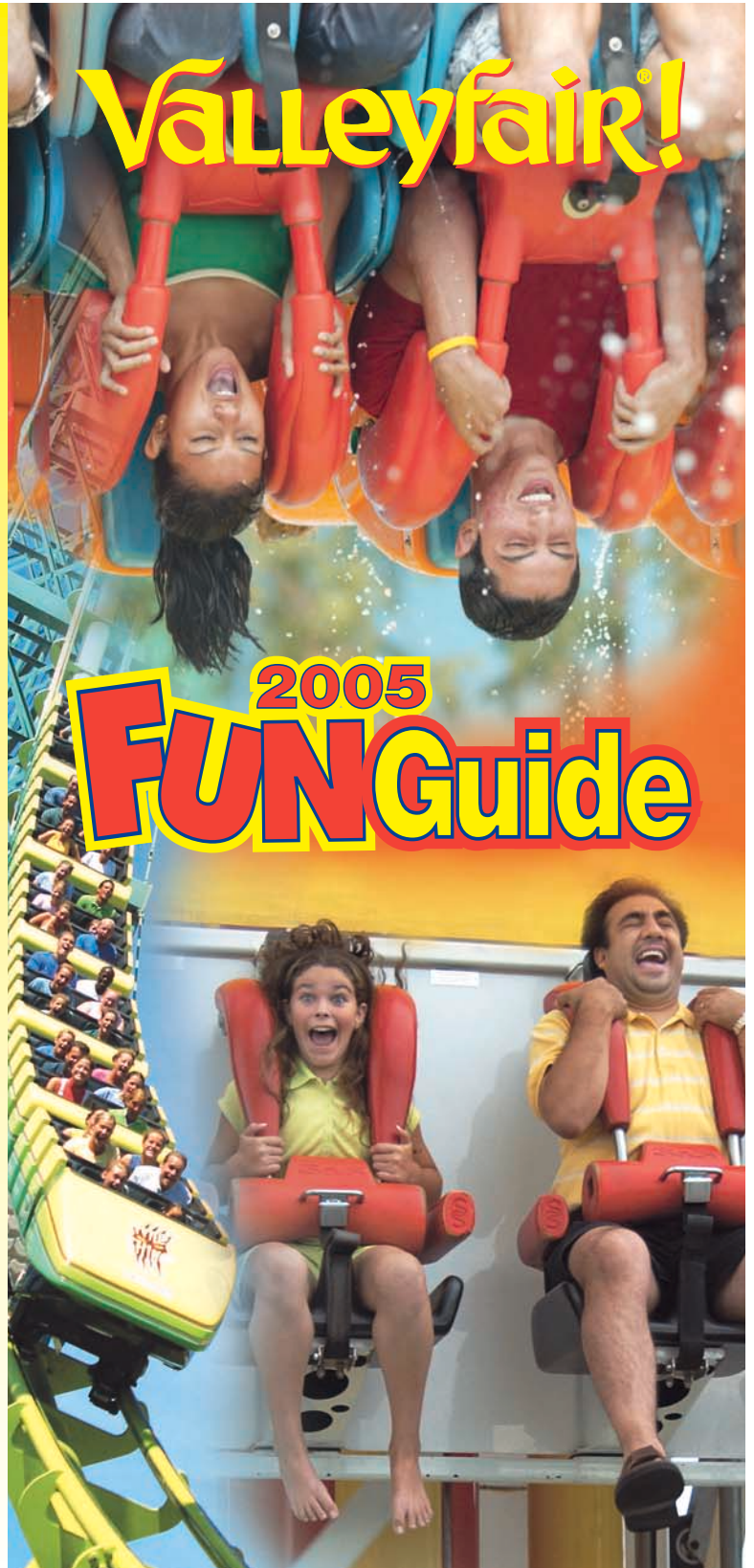

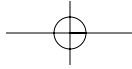

You'll flip for **RipTide** — a high-flying, gravity-defying, multi-spinning thrill with a splash of water.



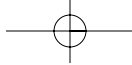

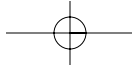

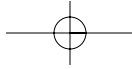

CHALLENGE PARK



Great thrills and family fun await you at **Challenge Park**, located in the southeast corner of Valleyfair (near Steel Venom). Challenge Park features exciting attractions like the extreme RipCord (an 18-story tethered free-fall), two 18-hole adventure golf courses, Can-Am style go-karts and bumper boats. Challenge Park is a separate charge attraction and requires Valleyfair admission to participate in its activities.

Helpful Information

Our Admission – Our admission allows you to enjoy rides, shows and Whitewater Country Waterpark all day long. Food, merchandise, games, some attractions and Challenge Park are extra charges. All posted prices, except merchandise and food, include Minnesota State Sales Tax.

Ride Availability – For your safety, rides may be closed due to weather conditions (high winds, rain or lightning), required maintenance or other causes. Closed rides will reopen as soon as possible. Water rides may be closed if the temperature falls below 65°. No rain checks or refunds are available.

Checks – Personal checks written for the exact amount may be used at the Ticket Booths to pay for admission tickets. Guests may also cash personal checks for up to \$150 at Guest Services with a valid driver's license and one major credit card. Checks are not accepted for food, games and merchandise, at Challenge Park, Skyscraper and separate charge attractions.

Credit Cards – Discover, MasterCard and Visa may be used at the Ticket Booths to purchase admission tickets, at most merchandise shops, at Challenge Park, Skyscraper, Coasters Restaurant, Stadium Pizza & Grill, Depot Refreshments, Atomic Pizza, Chicken & Rib Shack, Lunch Basket, Valleyfair Pizza, Northwoods Grill and the Bakery. Credit cards are not accepted at other food locations or for games.

Cash Machines – Automated Teller Machines (ATMs) are located outside the Admission gates, at Stadium Pizza & Grill and in the Hi-Test Arcade.

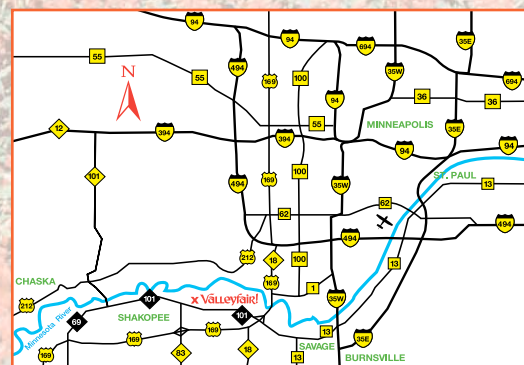
Canadian Money – Canadian currency may be used at the Ticket Booths to purchase admission tickets. Canadian currency may be exchanged for U.S. currency at Guest Services.

Strollers/Wagons/Wheelchairs – Strollers and wagons are available for rent. A limited number of wheelchairs are also available.

Picnics – Food or beverages may not be brought inside the Park. However, you can pack your own picnic to enjoy in the Picnic Cove, located just north of the Park. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the picnic area.

Dress Code – Guests are required to wear shoes, tops and shorts at all times while inside the Park. Clothing that disguises or alters a person's identity or clothing or exposed tattoos with profanity, illegal substances and other suggestive or offensive material are prohibited. Valleyfair has the sole discretion to determine what is appropriate.

Policies, procedures and requirements at Valleyfair may differ from other Parks within the Cedar Fair organization. All information contained in this brochure is subject to change.
